# WELCOME!

Welcome to the Canaan Lions Club's 2007 motocross season. The gate fee for spectators is \$10 for ages 7 through adult. Children 6 and under are admitted free of charge.

All race bikes must stay in the main parking area on race day. Spectators will park across the street from the racetrack. The handicap parking area is designated between the Clubhouse and the track entrance.

Chappy's Concessions at the Fish & Game Club kitchen will be open at 6:00 a.m. on race day with coffee and breakfast, and will remain open for the day. Hot dogs, burgers, fries, ice cream, soda, sausage, steak & cheese, etc., will be available for purchase.

Other vendors must register with the Mt. Cardigan Fish and Game Club and purchase a vendor's license. Vendors will pay a gate fee for each race, just as everyone else does -- NO EXCEPTIONS!

**NOTE: ANYONE WHO COMES TO THE TOWER REGARDING ANY ISSUE AND USES VERBALLY ABUSIVE LANGUAGE OR PHYSICALLY HARRASSING MANNERISMS WILL BE TOLD TO RETURN TO THEIR VEHICLE TO COOL OFF. ONCE CALMED DOWN, THEY ARE WELCOME TO RETURN TO THE TOWER TO DISCUSS THEIR ISSUES. IF THEY RETURN A SECOND TIME AND STILL DO NOT REMAIN CALM, THEY WILL BE ESCORTED OFF THE PREMISES BY LAW ENFORCEMENT. USE OF PROFANITY WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.**

Due to liability concerns, camping is no longer allowed on the grounds. There are campgrounds close by with reasonable rates and excellent accommodations. For info, call 603-523-7720 and leave a message.

For pedestrian safety, bicycles will not be allowed anywhere on the premises.

## **RIDERS' INFORMATION**

There must be a minimum of three registered participants to qualify for Championship points.

### **Fees:**

Gate Fee	\$10 per person 7 yrs. to adult (under 6 free)
Registration	\$20 per class
Association Fee	\$30 per person per year

### **Registration:**

Registration begins at 6:00 a.m. All riders will be required to register in the Canaan Motocross Association prior to registering for any races.

**IMPORTANT: YOU MUST HAVE A PHOTO ID OR BIRTH CERTIFICATE WITH YOU AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION.**

### **Consent:**

Riders under 18 years of age must have a signed and notarized Parental Consent Form. For your convenience, we will have a notary on-site.

### **Numbers:**

Numbers must be legible at the start of each race. Numbers must be on the right side, left side, and front of the bike. Protests of scores will not be allowed if numbering is illegible or inconsistent. All riders are required to confirm to these regulations. All numbers must be at least 8" in height, with the exception of 50CC, which must be at least 6" in height.

### **Flags & Markers:**

Green Flag	Start
Yellow Flag	Caution – no passing until beyond hazard
Black Flag	Rider disqualification
Red Flag	All racing stops immediately and wait for further instructions
Crossed Flags	½ race completed
Checkered & White Flags	2 laps remaining
White Flag	1 lap remaining
Checkered Flag	Finish

## **GENERAL RULES**

- 1. Due to a noise ordinance in Canaan, we request that NO bikes be started before 8:30 a.m. ALL bikes must have complete exhaust systems in order to race.**
2. Recommended Race Gear: racing boots, eye goggles, gloves, chest protectors, long sleeved shirts, racing pants with knee pads.
3. All helmets must fit, and straps should be fastened from the start of the race until you get into the pit area.
4. A mandatory Riders' Meeting will take place before each race. Practice will begin immediately following this meeting.
5. Any riders, mechanics, family, or friends using profanity, unsportsmanlike or disrespectful language or actions toward other riders, mechanics, spectators, or race officials, on or off the race track, shall be subject to disqualification for the day and may face further disqualification. The Canaan Lions Race Directors have the final say.
6. All riders, mechanics, pit crews, and promoters are expected to be fully aware of all of the rules and regulations of the Canaan Lions Raceway and will be required to abide by them.
7. Riders may not indulge in the use of drugs or alcohol before or during their scheduled races.
8. The Canaan Lions Raceway track is private property. Riding is allowed only during scheduled events.
9. **NO RIDING IN THE PIT AREA!** All competition motorcycles must be walked in the pit area. Motorcycles must be pushed by hand to the starting area. Riders should use every precaution to ensure the safety of all. Non-adherence will result in a disqualification.
10. No one except riders officially entered in an event may ride or practice on the day of the race. You must officially enter before practice or the start of the race.
11. Stopped, fallen, or disabled riders must take precautions to ensure the safety of the other riders when restarting their motorcycles and/or re-entering the race.
12. Outside Assistance: No one but authorized motocross personnel and racers are allowed on the track during a race/event. Anyone wishing to be on the track must get permission from the motocross staff.
13. Unauthorized Entry or Unsafe Spectator Reactions to Rider Injuries: If a rider is injured, and you wish to enter the track to be with the rider, you must either have permission from or be escorted by motocross staff. Only trained staff and medical personnel are allowed to attend to downed riders. We will make every effort to reunite an injured rider with friends or family when it is safe and time to do so.
14. Riders leaving the course must re-enter at the next safe location, with no attempt to shorten the course or maintain or gain advantage.
15. A rider whose motorcycle is disabled may push it to complete the lap, provided he/she does not endanger or interfere with other riders. All riders who cross the finish line with the checkered flag will receive motocross points.

## GENERAL RULES, cont'd.

16. A rider must be ready when his/her class is scheduled to run. A rider with mechanical or equipment problems may signal the starter to delay the start of the moto for up to two minutes in order to correct the problem.
17. Track officials and promoters shall decide the number of motorcycles allowed to participate in a given class. In the event of an excessive number of riders entered in one class, that class may be separated into two or more groups and scored separately.
18. All riders starting an event on a particular size machine must complete that event with the same size bike (with the exceptions of Open, Senior, Super Senior, and Enduro Classes).
19. All bikes are required to have seats in order to race.
20. This is a list of the bikes we have found to be racing at the Canaan Lions Motocross. If you don't see your bike listed and would like to discuss what class you will be put in, please feel free to call 603-523-7720 and leave a message. NOTE: Each Enduro must have headlight and brake light to be considered an Enduro.

## Advancement Points:

12 or fewer riders  
1<sup>st</sup> 6 points  
2<sup>nd</sup> 4 points  
3<sup>rd</sup> 3 points

More than 12 riders  
1<sup>st</sup> 6 points  
2<sup>nd</sup> 4 points  
3<sup>rd</sup> 3 points  
4<sup>th</sup> 3 points

(Advancement Points and Championship Points are two separate entities.)

Rider Advancement Points will accumulate through the third race (July 7). Eleven points will advance a novice to amateur and amateur to expert, with no Championship or Track Advancement Points being carried forward.

It is the rider's responsibility to pick the level of competition he/she can be competitive in. If you were one of the top novice or amateur riders in 2006, you will be bumped to the next level of competition at the discretion of the motocross committee. It will be in your best interest to begin competing in the class best suited to your ability, since Championship Points will not be carried forward when your Advancement Points move you into the next class. Also, if you race in two classes, you could or will be bumped up in both classes.

## Championship Points:

All other rules compiled by the committee will be available on each race day.
